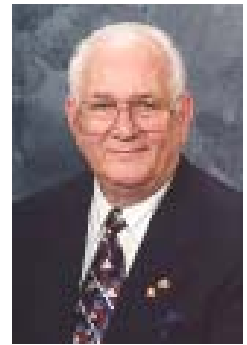

Collect the empty envelopes and, at the end of every two weeks, mail them to us so that we will be able to issue a contribution receipt to everyone who contributes. In the event the contributor fails to complete the return address on the envelope, please obtain it from the contribution check and complete it for them.**

Some of the checks you receive may be made out to United Christian Fund. **This letter will serve as your authorization to simply endorse and cash or deposit them.**

May I also suggest that it will take only a short time to write a brief thank you card to each person who helps you. Many times this is the encouragement our contributors need to continue **"Turning Tragedy Into Triumph!"** A simple post card may stimulate years of continued giving to others who suffer tragedy.

Many of our recipients have asked how they may repay United Christian Fund. There are two things that we ask you to do, the most important of which is to respond, with a gift, to one UCF appeal each month. The other is also very important. Our contributors rejoice to hear that their efforts are not in vain; so, a letter of testimony of how UCF has blessed you is important.
